This one-day workshop at the IDHMC will bring humanities scholars together to learn about using digital mapping techniques to facilitate research and teaching. A digital maps exhibition will be followed by a session on optimizing Neatline digital maps and a session that discusses both using historical maps and 3D mapping. We will conclude with a communal brainstorming session to discuss participants' own ideas for mapping projects, as well as future avenues for digital mapping at A&M.
